### **Startup City Scholars Plans for Spring 2021**

- This will be a unique, demanding learning experience for students who are serious about entrepreneurship and want to know how to launch successful enterprises.
- Participate in the joint College New Venture Challenge (CNVC) class between the University of Chicago and University of Illinois—for course credit!
- Applicants may be eligible for a \$5,000 scholarship to spend the semester working on a student-led venture.
- UIUC-led teams must include a University of Chicago student on your team.
- Accepted teams are eligible to win prizes in the form of **SAFE funds** from a pool of up to \$100,000!
- Meet Chicago's tech leaders and investors who can help launch your company.

#### **Take Virtual Classes**

- Receive credit for University of Chicago's College New Venture Challenge (CNVC) through the University of Illinois TE398 course—taught virtually from University of Chicago.
- Take courses in person at UIUC (if applicable) and online.
- Access to 200-400 level CS, ECE, and TE courses offered exclusively for the City Scholars program.

#### Live Where You're Comfortable

- Live on campus in Urbana, at home with family, or in Chicago—your choice.
- Virtual events connect you with City Scholars students in a semester-long cohort.

#### How are teams organized?

**ALREADY HAVE A TEAM?** If you already have a team, submit your official proposal by Nov. 20. Note that all teams must include at least one UChicago team member.

**WANT TO JOIN A TEAM?** If you don't have your own team, you may join a team. The team should list you on their application which is due on Nov. 20. However, you may join a team after the Nov. 20 deadline. Attend the Dec. 1 event to meet teams that have been accepted into the program, and seek an invitation to join one of those teams. The deadline to join a team is Jan. 6, 2021.

NOW THROUGH NOV. 20	<b>Submit the Interest Form</b> All students, either leading a UIUC team or joining another team, must submit an interest form. Interest Forms are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis. Students will be notified if they are eligible to participate and eligible to receive the scholarship by Nov. 20th, 2020. Eligibility does not guarantee selection for the program.
