## Turning the System On

- Press the **[POWER]** button on the projector remote.

## Using the Resident PC

- Make sure the resident PC is properly connected to the AV system – see ***Setting Up the Resident PC*** below.
- If the resident PC is not already selected, press the **[SEARCH]** button on the projector remote.

## Using a Laptop

- Connect your laptop to the end of the HDMI cable that is not connected to the input panel.
- Press the **[SEARCH]** button on the projector remote.

**Note: Depending on your laptop model, you may need an adapter. Adapters can be borrowed on short term loan (4hrs.) from an Engineering IT Help Desk.**

## Turning the System Off

- Press the **[POWER]** button on the projector remote. It will take a minute or two to cool off and shutdown.

## Setting Up the Resident PC

- The resident PC located in the lectern must be properly connected to the AV system to work as expected.
- The lectern has a bundle of three cables that need to be connected to the various ports on the North wall of the room
- Ensure the power, network, and VGA+Audio cables are properly connected based on figure 1.
  - Ensure the network cable is plugged into the front, left port (**HAP04-36**).
  - Ensure the VGA is plugged into **Computer Input** and not **Monitor Output**.
  - The power cable can be plugged into any outlet. Do not unplug the power cable from the black, wall-mounted equipment cabinet.
