A request for a dual degree must include a compelling explanation for how a secondary degree, as opposed to additional course work or a minor, is needed to achieve specific educational or career goals. Students are required to reside in The Grainger College of Engineering for a minimum of two full semesters (summers and winters excluded) to receive an engineering degree. Students are required to have a 2.25 cumulative GPA to pursue the ILEE Dual Degree.

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS - PLANNING FORM AND SIGNATURES:

- 1) Make a course plan for all semesters at Illinois (including past and present); indicate any credit you may have received via AP or proficiency exams. Make sure to:
 - Include all semesters with *both* degrees.
 - Identify each semester (e.g., please write Fall 2021, Spring 2020). For each semester:
 - Indicate your college of enrollment; e.g., ACES, ENGR, LAS.
 - List all courses you plan on taking. Include the credit hours for each in parentheses, ARCH412 (3), ECE210 (4).
 - Include the total number of hours at the bottom of each semester.
- 2) Make sure your plan accounts for all requirements for both degrees, including 30 additional hours of courses for the ILEE degree (a minimum of 158 total hours).
- 3) Make sure your plan accounts for at least 12 hours of distinct, advanced-level coursework in your ILEE degree.
- 4) Meet with and obtain a signature from your primary degree academic adviser.
- 5) Meet with the ILEE Academic Adviser to discuss plan and obtain a signature.
 - ILEE advisers will check with you that all classes listed satisfy the ILEE degree requirements, discuss any plan to gain access to classes as necessary, and discuss prerequisites and timing of classes (i.e., not every class is offered every semester).
- 6) Send this completed Dual-Degree form to engineering@illinois.edu for college review. The College will review your plan to ensure it satisfies all requirements. If approved, your form will be signed and processed.
