The **Illini Success** three-year trend report summarizes the outcomes of the most recent graduating classes. Readers are encouraged to be sensitive to the personal, social, and professional impact of the COVID-19 during this time period. It is important to take *sample size* and *knowledge rates* into consideration when interpreting these results. The overall knowledge rate of 59% for the 2021-2022 graduation cohort is comparable to the previous two years. It is also important to note that **knowledge rate differs considerably** across subgroups of graduates across the years.

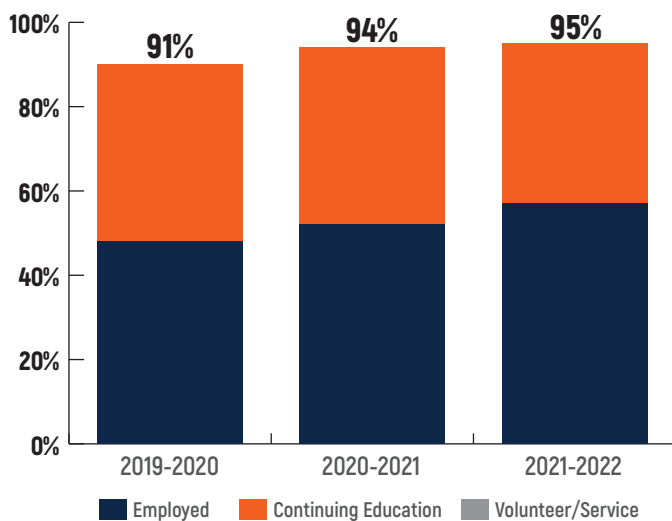
Across the past three years, **a strong picture of success** for Illinois bachelor's degree graduates remains for those who shared their graduate outcomes. In many colleges, departments, and majors this year, there was an **increase in secured first destination rate**, and, in most areas, reported **annual salaries have continued to increase or remained fairly steady**.

Secured first destination rates remain high, but **knowledge rates vary** across colleges and majors. Readers are encouraged to keep in mind that the report only details known information and refrain from making assumptions about the outcomes for the graduates for which there is no data.
