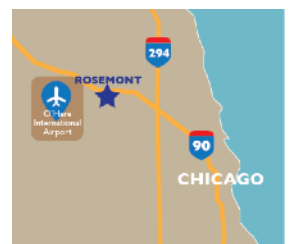
Hotels and Parking
