All students still needing 126 to complete their degree will need to take the CS 128 and CS 222 sequence.

CS 124, 128, 173, 225 and 233 all have a section dedicated to only those currently in one of the CS majors and a separate section for non-major section. Only CS 233 non-major sections will have staggered registration that follows the CS timeline listed above. CS 233 major section will be open to any FA22 and earlier and then follow stagger for later cohorts.

- **CS 210 and CS 211 will open to FA23 cohort on 11/18, first time freshman will be restricted. Students must meet prerequisites and have junior standing. If there are any remaining seats just the CS 210 section will open to non-majors.
- ***CompE majors will have access to CS 400 levels on 11/20 except for CS 491 and CS 498 sections.

CS 277 & CS 307 major sections will have a major only section for DS majors. The major section of CS 277 & CS 307 will open to undeclared business students on 11/15.

CS 340 will be restricted to CS +/& majors only until after all the admitted ICT's have been processed. If any seats remain in CS 340, they will be opened to nonmajors on 1/21.

All 400 level CS courses will restrict the freshman cohort of those that started Fall 2024 from enrolling in the class and prerequisites will be enforced. To find out the prerequisites for a course look at the entry for the course in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer. It will also list in the section notes any other restrictions on the course.
