Fall 2025 Computer Science Undergraduate Course Restrictions

The CS Department will release RESTRICTIONS on given dates, if additional release dates are announced it will be on the CS Advising piazza. A date given does not automatically mean there will be seats available to release on that date. It is not possible to provide an exact time of day when restrictions or seats will be released. We will attempt to adjust restrictions between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm on that date. If the day is busy, it may take additional time after 5:00pm.

CS 124, 128, 173, 225 and 233 all have a section dedicated to only those currently in one of the CS majors and a separate section for non-major section. The nonmajor sections will be open to all cohorts with the exception of CS 233. Only CS 233 non-major sections will have staggered registration that follows the CS timeline listed above. CS 233 major section will be open to any FA23 and earlier and then follow stagger for later cohorts.

Students should mark sections as "Favorites" in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer to be notified when additional seats have been released.

CS 210 and CS 211: These courses will open to FA24 cohort on 4/21. Students must meet prerequisites and have junior standing. If there are remaining seats only the CS 210 section will open to non-majors.

CS 340: This course will open to all CS &/+ majors first and may open to other majors outside of CS-ENG after incoming ICT's are processed. CS &/+ majors also have the option to take the CS 233/341 sequence. CS GENG are required to take 233 and 341.

All 400 level CS courses will restrict first-time freshman from enrolling in the course and prerequisites will be enforced. To find out the prerequisites for a course look at the entry for the course in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer. CS 307 will have a major only section for DS majors and a separate section for all other majors.

CE majors will have access to CS 400 levels on 5/2 with the exception of CS 491 and CS 498 sections.
