Students must also complete the campus cultural studies requirement by completing (i) one western/comparative culture(s) course, (ii) one non-western culture(s) course, and (iii) one U.S. Minority Culture(s) course from the General Education cultural studies lists. Most students select general education courses that simultaneously satisfy these cultural studies requirements.

³Advanced Composition is satisfied by completing TAM 324 and ME 470.

⁴ME 470 is taken either the first or second semester of the fourth year, according to the student's UIN (FA if UIN is odd and SP if UIN is even). MechSE elective is taken the other semester.
