The CS Department will only release RESTRICTIONS on given dates. A date given does not automatically mean there will be seats available to release on that date. It is not possible to provide an exact time of day when seats will be released. We will attempt to adjust restrictions between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm on that date. If the day is busy, it may take additional time after 5:00pm.

Students should mark sections as "Favorites" in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer to be notified when additional seats have been released.

CS 124, 128, 173, 225 and 233 all have a lecture dedicated to only those currently in one of the CS majors and a separate lecture for non-major section.

CS 210 and CS 211 will open to FA24 cohort on 11/17, first time freshman will be restricted. Students must meet prerequisites and have junior standing. If there are any remaining seats only the CS 210 section will open to non-majors.

CS 233 The major section will be open to FA22 & FA23 to start, and the non-major will follow the staggered registration timeline.

CS 277 & CS 307 has a section dedicated only to those in a DS major and a separate section for non-majors. The major section will be open to FA22 & FA23 to start, and the non-major will follow the staggered registration timeline. The major section of CS 277 & CS 307 will open to undeclared business students on 11/15.

CS 340 will exclude Grainger CS Engineering students to be able to register. There will be a limited number of seats available for non-majors. If you receive a "reserved closed" error message, all non-major seats are currently full. Unable to have limited reserved seats open currently. We will open seats before the semester begins.

CS 425 we will only have this course open to FA22 cohort and earlier until the first day of classes due to the class size. At that time, we will remove the FA23 and FA24 cohort.

All 400 level CS courses will restrict the freshman cohort of those that started Fall 2025 from enrolling in the class and prerequisites will be enforced. To find out the prerequisites for a course look at the entry for the course in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer. It will also list in the section notes any other restrictions on the course.
