The CS Department will release RESTRICTIONS on given dates. If additional release dates are announced, it will be on the CS Advising piazza. A date given does not automatically mean there will be seats available to release on that date. It is not possible to provide an exact time of day when restrictions will be released. We will attempt to adjust restrictions between the hours of 9:00am and 5:00pm on that date. If the day is busy, it may take additional time after 5:00pm.

Students should mark sections as “Favorites” in the Class Schedule (found in Course Explorer) to be notified when additional seats have been released.

CS 124, 128, 173 and 233 all have sections dedicated to only those currently in one of the CS majors and a separate section for non-majors. The non-major section of each course will be open to all cohorts except for CS 233. It will be open to all FA 24 and earlier, the open to FA25 on 4/20.

CS 210 and CS 211 will open to FA24 cohort on and earlier from the start and FA 25 on 4/20. First time freshman will be restricted. Students must meet prerequisites and have junior standing. If there are any remaining seats, only the CS 210 section will open to non-majors.

CS 277 and CS 307 will have a major section for DS majors and a separate section for all other majors. The major and non-major section will follow the staggered registration dates.

CS 340 will exclude Grainger CS Engineering students to be able to register from all sections. There will be a limited number of seats available for non-majors. If you receive a “reserved closed” error message, all non-major seats are currently full.

All 400 level CS courses will restrict the first-time freshman from enrolling in the course, and prerequisites will be enforced. To find out the prerequisites for a course, look at the entry for the course in the Class Schedule found in Course Explorer. It will also list in the section notes any other restrictions on the course.
