### **Walter E. Hanson Graduate Study Award**

This award is presented by the consulting engineering firm of Hanson Professional Services Inc. to honor Walter E. Hanson who founded the company in Springfield, Ill., in 1954. Walt Hanson taught engineering courses at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign while completing his master's degree in civil engineering. That pursuit was briefly interrupted after Walt enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served overseas during World War II, after which he returned to Illinois to finish his master's degree and to become an associate professor of civil engineering. It was during Walt's tenure at Illinois that he wrote several papers dealing with both structural and foundation engineering and joined Professors Ralph Peck and Tom Thornburn in writing "Foundation Engineering," a textbook that is still used by practicing engineers and students today. To recognize the importance of the understanding of soil-structure interaction in the design of foundations, the award is presented to a graduating senior who has an interest in both structural and geotechnical engineering and intends to pursue a master's degree.

### **Ira O. Baker Award in Civil Engineering**

Ira O. Baker, a civil engineering faculty member from 1875 to 1925, and Department Head for 39 of those 50 years, initiated the Ira O. Baker Prizes in 1923. The purpose of the prizes is to recognize outstanding seniors, and thus serve as an incentive to undergraduate students to put forth their best efforts. In addition to superior scholastic achievement, which is of primary importance, the selection is based on the students' activities in organizations and on personal characteristics that include initiative, reliability, and potential. The Baker prizes have been awarded to the top-ranking seniors in civil engineering every spring since 1924. The winners are selected by the faculty of the department.
