Qualified candidates are sought for a Postdoctoral Research Associate position in Dr. Caleb Brooks' Research Group in the Department of Nuclear, Plasma, and Radiological Engineering at the University of Illinois. Dr. Brooks' research is in nuclear thermal hydraulics, and his group specializes in thermo-fluid dynamics of nuclear systems and reactor flows. This focus includes system-level and subsystem-related research on current and advanced reactor technologies. As director of the Multiphase Thermo-fluid Dynamics Laboratory (MTDL) at UIUC, Dr. Brooks and his research group study important heat transfer and fluid flow behavior such as flow instability, critical heat flux, two-phase transport, natural circulation, and other critical phenomena to nuclear reactor safety. The high-fidelity data generated in the MTDL are used for system-code and computational fluid dynamics (CFD) code validation, as well as development of improved physical modeling. A successful candidate would assist in the continuation of these research efforts as well as emerging opportunities related to micro-reactors.
